

A virus, for example, may sit undetected on your computer monitoring online usage, recording credit card information, passwords or identity information, advises Interworks, a technology company.

Most of the time viruses make entry to your computer or other device through attachments or links. Here are four common places viruses and malware lie in wait.

- . Downloaded purchases: Downloading software, games, files, and other technology from the internet is not without risk. There are many reputable sites, but unknown downloads may carry viruses.
- **?**. Network links: More than one device hooked up to a network means any computer on that network is vulnerable should one device pick up a virus. All connected computers can be compromised by one virus.
- Email attachments: Computer How To Guide States that emails are one of the most common ways viruses are downloaded onto computers. Opening an email from someone you don't know can trigger malware or a virus. Never click on a link or open an attachment from an unknown sender.
- . Messaging apps: Apps that enable people to lacktrianglecommunicate through chat on desktop or mobile systems can be spreaders of viruses, too. Do not visit links posted in messaging applications unless you are sure they are from safe sites. Sometimes messenger services can be hacked, so even if links come from relatives or friends, verify those links before clicking on them.

New viruses are being created daily and computers need protection. Good anti-virus programs can help, but computer users also need to do their part to avoid contracting viruses.
