

**REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS (RFQ) FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES IN SUPPORT OF DRINKING WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS (SFY23-62)**

The Town of Weston (the "Town") requests for Statements of Qualifications from qualified engineering firms licensed in the State of Connecticut to provide engineering services for the proposed improvements to complete a Preliminary Engineering Report and future design of selected water system improvements to a portion of the Town of Weston's Drinking Water System known as the "Booster Treatment Station". The construction phase of this project will be funded in part by the State of Connecticut, Department of Public Health, Drinking Water State Revolving Fund. Neither the State of Connecticut nor any of its departments, agencies, or employees is or will be a party to this request for qualifications.

The Booster Treatment Station serves numerous Weston public schools and town buildings with a maximum demand of 20,000 gallons per day. The existing pump station, tanks, controls, piping, and treatment systems are between 40 and 50 years old and are well past their useful life. The Town proposed a new water station which will safely and efficiently operate current demands as well as meet potential increased demands of no greater than 49,000 gallons per day. System improvements shall include a include a new building, atmospheric storage tanks, VFD boosters, well controls, alarms, and treatment equipment for chlorination, phosphates, and PFAS remediation. The new facility and improvements will be located on town-owned land in the vicinity of the existing station.
