SPRAY PROGRAM: Claudia presented a cost analysis of the organic compost tea. As presented, it is a fairly costly solution but the right one. The program may need to be delayed until next year but we will still require an organic solution this year.

POLLINATOR PATHWAY: The PP group are planting two areas with native pollinator plants – in front of the Onion Barn and in front of the root cellar at Jarvis.

LIBRARY: Lou made all the changes at the library. They look great!

MAINTENANCE BIDS: Jonathan received three bids – Weston Gardens, Robles and Weston Arborists. Jonathan is going to reach back out to Robles for a breakdown of his fees by contract. After that, a final decision will be made.
