 this week going very well; hardest part is parents forgetting to sign on.
 Governor issued guidelines for summer day camps; discussed with district
 and Parks & Recreation. Inclined to offer only online camps due to restrictions
 and associated challenges; talked to several companies and Weston
 teachers; looking at theatre, music, finance, science, art, yoga, and chess
 programs.
- WYS update (Laura): Difficult to sort out the needs of Weston families; have done some one-to-one support and support groups; keeping up to date on resources and what others are doing in Town; doing fun video program; not seeing level of parent interest in types of programs usually do.
- WHS students (Bridget, Knox, Emma): Bridget not much going on with the school year almost over; on 6/12, doing graduation with large car parade on School Road. Knox - hit 5 week mark on community service - provided around \$2500 of unpaid work for Peter's; student government broadcasts going well. Emma - for some students, the experience is positive, but difficult for others. Shara Kolodney added that she thinks students at WMS are hitting online fatigue.
- NAMI liaison (Jane): NAMI can offer support to groups online. Separately, maybe can do online book discussion. Laura Cleary will connect Jane with the Friends of the Weston Library.
- School Liaisons:
 - HES (Charlene): Nothing to report, but notes seeing that kids enjoy connecting with their classmates and instructors in the WOW programs.
 - WIS (Michele T.): Moving forward with end of year celebration and art show online. Doing google meet for 5th to 6th grade transition.
