



## Resolution

**WHEREAS:** In 2023, the Town of Weston was notified of grant funding award through Connecticut's Volkswagen (VW) EVSE ZEV Infrastructure Program (ZIP) administered by the Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (CT DEEP) to install two (2) dual-port electric vehicle chargers at the Department of Public Works (DPW) facility.

**WHEREAS:** At the time of grant application, the total project cost was estimated as \$51,033.00 to be offset by a \$20,000.00 incentive offered by Eversource. As such, the original grant award amount under the CT DEEP grant was noted as \$20,171.45 with a Town share required for the project in the amount of \$10,861.55. The CT DEEP award amount represented 65% funding of the project balance after deducting the Eversource incentive. The Town share was to be paid using a portion of APRA funds as well as money from the Town building and repairs fund.

**WHEREAS:** Since the time of original grant award through the VW ZIP Program, the two (2) dual-port electrical vehicle charging stations have been installed at the DPW facility and the total project cost came in under budget with a total of \$39,604.00.

**WHEREAS:** The Town has also received the full \$20,000.00 incentive from Eversource. Consequently, the remaining project balance is \$19,604.00 and CT DEEP has revised the grant award amount to reflect 65% of the project balance with a new award amount of \$12,742.60 with a Town share of \$6,861.40.

**WHEREAS:** The CT DEEP has requested the Town enter into a Personal Services Agreement with the State of Connecticut to receive the \$12,742.60 in grant funding towards the project and has requested the Board of Selectmen authorize the First Selectwoman to execute the agreement through Town resolution.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that Samantha Nestor, First Selectwoman, hereby is authorized to execute on behalf of the Town of Weston a Personal Services Agreement with the State of Connecticut for financial assistance to complete work as described above in the amount of \$12,742.60.
