**Tuesday, May 7, 2024 Meeting Minutes

Police Board Chairman Gralnick called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

Police Board Chairman Gralnick made a request to approve the meeting minutes dated April 2, 2024, Police Board Vice-Chairman Ottomano moved and Police Board Commissioner Egan seconded, and unanimously approved.

Cannondale Road – Request from Wilton Local Traffic Authority (LTA) to make Cannondale Road a “No Thru Truck” roadway and install a 3 way stop sign at the intersection of Cannondale Road and Wampum Hill Road. The Commissioners are not in favor for a “No Thru Truck” signs. At the Commissioners next meeting on June 4, 2024 they will consider a 3 way stop sign at the intersection of Cannondale Road and Wampum Hill Road.

Chairman Gralnick changed the order of the Agenda because residents were in attendance.

Old Redding Road – Petition supporting speed bumps, speed limit reduction and cross walk markings on Old Redding Road in front of Aspetuck Valley Country Club. The requirements for putting in speed bumps does not meet the requirements on Old Redding Road. The police department will step up enforcement near Aspetuck Valley Country Club. The Chief and Captain will talk to the Manager of the Aspetuck Valley Country Club.

Chiefs Report – We currently have 2 officers out on workman’s compensation. The speed enforcement reimbursement grant came in.

The Police Department has not received any donations for April.

Captain Brodacki has been working with Daigle Law regarding the accreditation updates which is ongoing.

Citizen of the Year Award – was discussed in Executive Session.

Police Board Commissioner Gralnick made a request to go into Executive Session at 8:10 PM, Police Board Commissioner Egan seconded and unanimously approved.

The Commission came out of Executive Session at 8:40 PM.

Commissioner Egan made a motion to award the 2024 Citizen of the Year award to Carol Baldwin and Ellen McCormick for their vision and tireless efforts at Lachat Town Farm. The vote was all in favor. The meeting adjourned at 9:00 PM.
