Kiwanis helped construct wooden outdoor tables for the farm, with funds from the Gaynes family

Committee Reports:

- A) **Buildings:** (Carol) Septic and Grease trap clean-out will be scheduled for May. Trenching of a water line to the Community Garden is planned for April. The new sump pump seems to thankfully be keeping the basement dry despite the extremely heavy rains. The Verdi electrician will be coming soon to do some electrical improvements to the Offutt Center.
- B) Grounds: (Kat) DPW will be making improvements to the gravel parking area by the

- CG on April 4. Ellen procured 4 bids for the spraying of the Hemlock to kill the fungus that it has. The least expensive company will be chosen. They will use a natural spray.
- C) Barnyard: (Kat) Animals are happy!
- D) **Bee-Yard:** (Erica) Three new packages of bees will be installed. There is a honey tasting program planned for June 6. Erica is working on a native bee "observatory" for the farm, which will be part of the children's Good Earth Gardeners curriculum at the farm.
