DISCUSSION/DECISION CON'T: REQUEST TO PAVE PORTION OF DRIVEWAY AT 7 BRIAR OAK DRIVE, LOT C, BREGY SUBDIVISION [STEVEN KRASNER, OWNER]

Steven Krasner, property owner, came before the Commission and presented storm drainage information and a letter dated October 4, 2019, from Dolphin Construction Management, addressed to the Commission, which attests that paving a portion of the driveway will not result in a volume increase of storm water runoff, an increase in the speed of storm water discharge, and/or an increase in natural or preexisting rate of soil erosion on the property.

The members reviewed the letter and a discussion ensued with Mr. Krasner.

Chairman Edgar made a motion that the Commission approve the request to pave a portion of the driveway at 7 Briar Oak Drive, Lot C, Bregy Subdivision, subject to review and approval of the Town Engineer. Seconded by Harry Falber. All in favor, the motion carried (5-0). Vice Chairman Saltzman and Sally Korsh absent.
