<u>DISCUSSION/DECISION: DETERMINATION OF EXEMPTION FOR A FARM POND, CHESTNUT FARM, 227 LYONS PLAIN ROAD (VIVIAN SIMONS)</u>

Bob Walpuck and Vivian Simons came forward and presented the plans. They explained that with the dry summer last year they had to do extensive watering of the fields to keep the plants alive. They stated that there used to be a pond in another location on the property. Mr. Schwarz stated that he wants the Commission to do site walk and want to know that it is essential to the operation of the farm. He questioned what affect a pond would have on the wetlands up above the area. Mr. von Rosenvinge questioned if there was another location that could be utilized. Mr. Walpuck explained that they did test holes in an extreme dry time and got water at 8 feet down. Ms. Simons stated that they have a farm and in order to keep the farm running they need to make money and they can't make money if the plants die from lack of water. Ms. Schlecter stated that they would need to know what the rate would be and how much water it would draw. Mr. Schwarz stated that they will walk the property on March 5th.
