

04/09/2020 COVID-19 Update

We are sad to report that another one of our neighbors has lost his battle with COVID-19. Our deepest and most sincere condolences go out to the family and friends of the deceased.

In addition, another 4 Weston Residents have tested positive. While progress has been made toward flattening the curve, the disease continues to accelerate and remains a threat to us all. Social distancing and isolation are our best hope of defeating COVID-19.

In response to Governor Lamont's announcement that CT schools will be closed until at least 05/20/2020, the Town of Weston will continue to maintain its closure status accordingly. In the event we are able to open particular facilities or services earlier, we will announce changes to the public as they occur. As of today, all Town facilities, parks and playgrounds remain closed to the public. This includes all athletic fields, the running track and parking lots at the Weston Public Schools.

As we approach the holiday weekend we want to remind everyone out on our roads to use caution. This includes motor vehicle operators, bicyclists and pedestrians alike. Drivers, please slow down and be alert to the many people walking our roads. Bicyclists, ride no more than 2 wide and obey all traffic laws. Pedestrians, walk on the left side of the road, facing oncoming traffic, stay to the right and be alert to all vehicular traffic. If you plan to hike at Trout Brook Preserve, Do Not park on Bradley Road. When the parking lot is full you should find an alternate location to enjoy your hike. Dog walkers are reminded to clean up after your dog and not leave a mess behind, your neighbors will appreciate it!

For those shopping or enjoying take-out meals, we encourage you to support our many local businesses. When going to a store in person, it is recommended that you wear a cloth mask, gloves and wash your hands before and after your trip. Please dispose of your personal protective equipment properly and do not drop them in parking lots. It is also important to follow the store directed social distancing measures.
