

Connecticut is currently allowing people age 75+ to register for a COVID-19 vaccine.

To register, visit <https://dphsubmissions.ct.gov/OnlineVaccine>.

Each person must have **their own** email address to register. After you register, you will receive confirmation if the submission was successful. After that, it can take up to 2 weeks to receive an email inviting you to fill out the health questionnaire and register through VAMS for your appointment to get the first vaccine. (Check your spam folder too.)

If you do not have internet access or you need help registering online, then please call the Senior Center (203) 222-2608.

SCHEDULING A VACCINE ONLINE

1 REGISTER

Register Online

Click the provided link to sign up for Connecticut's Vaccine Administration Management System and supply your personal information and medical history.

2 HEAR BACK

Receive Approval E-mail

Receive an e-mail from **no-reply@email.vams.cdc.gov** which will guide you through the VAMS registration and scheduling process for receiving the vaccine.

3 SCHEDULE YOUR VACCINE APPOINTMENT

Pick a time slot

Once you receive your approval e-mail, you may search for a vaccination clinic near you and select an available time slot. Keep in mind: Due to statewide demand, your appointment may be several weeks into the future.
