VITAL STATISTICS

The Town Clerk is also the Registrar of Vital Statistics for the Town of Weston. Principal statutory provisions relating to these duties are found in Sections 7-36 through 7-76 and 19a-42 of the Connecticut General Statutes.

As the Registrar of Vital Statistics, it is our duty to ascertain as accurately as possible all births, marriages, deaths and fetal deaths which occur in Weston. In accordance with the provisions of the law, we must make and perfect all records of vital events occurring within the Town.

Only a Registrar of Vital Statistics or the Commissioner of Public Health may issue or cause to be issued certificates of birth, marriage, death or fetal death. Notarized copies of vital records have no legal status (CGS 7-62a).

Certified copies of vital events (birth, marriage, death) that occurred in Weston are available from the Town Clerk's office. Vital records and genealogical information for Weston begins as early as 1787. Prior to that year, genealogists may find information from the Town of Fairfield.
