Consideration / Approval April 2, 2019 Meeting Minutes

Police Board Chairman Brady made a motion to approve the April 2, 2019 meeting minutes, Police Board Commissioner Moch seconded, motion passed unanimously, Commissioner Egan arrived at 7:20 PM after the vote.

## 1. Chief Report

- a) Current Monthly Reports / OT / Budget (Changes) Overtime trend is down. Vehicle Maintenance is going over budget the older cars needed repairs and the uniform budget will be over (we had to outfit a new officer).
  - b) Poss Computer System / Payroll System Fully Implemented. Poss is working well.

  - e) Facility Long Term Plan Board of Selectmen approved Brian Hume's, Architect to draw up plans for the first phase renovation of the police department. Waiting for contract to be signed by Brian Hume's and the Town.
  - f) New Vehicle Update Board of Finance approved two new vehicles. Two vehicles are on order they should be in sometime in July then they have to be outfitted with a backcage, graphics, sirens etc.
