

Hello Weston. First Selectwoman Sam Nestor here with an important Covid update.

This week there is an increase of 24 individuals since our last update on November 19, 2021. Up 24 cases in the past 2 weeks. The total accumulated Covid numbers for Weston are at 743.

Weston's cases are on the rise and four of our surrounding towns are in the red zone.

Masks are still required in all Town owned properties as well as at Weston Schools.

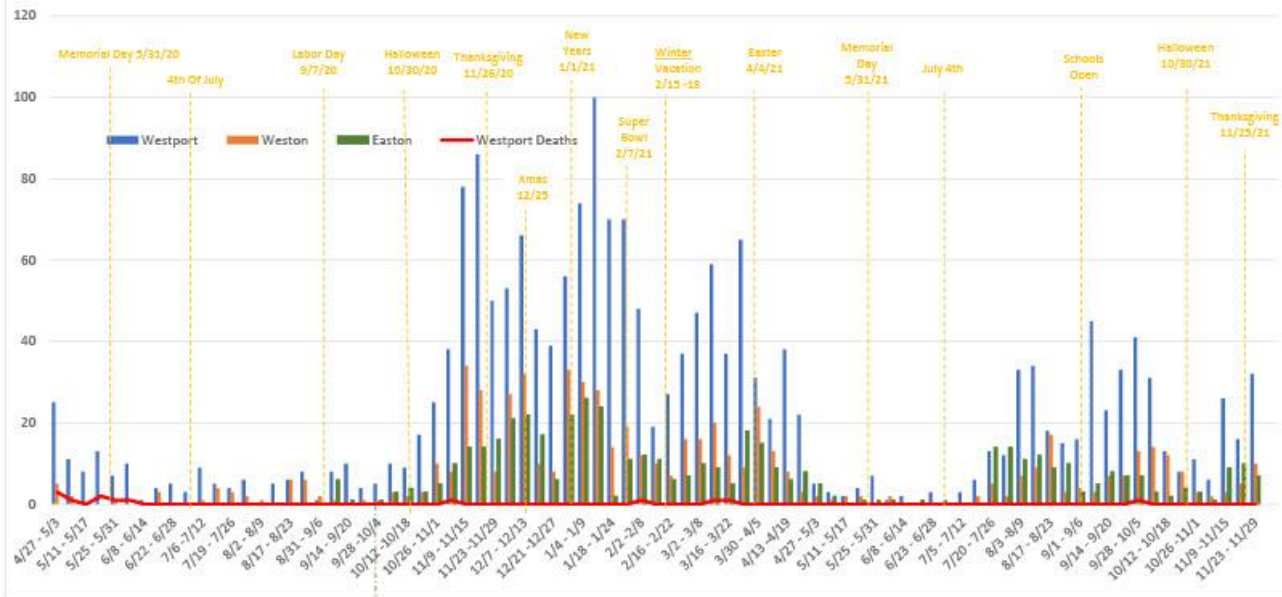
