

Hello Weston. First Selectwoman Sam Nestor here with an important Covid update.

**This week there is an increase of 10 individuals since our last update on December 3, 2021. Up 23 cases over the past 2 weeks. The total accumulated Covid numbers for Weston as of December 9, 2021 are 753.**

Weston's cases continue to be on the rise and we are now back in the "redzone" or high rate of transmission.

Masks are still required in all Town owned properties as well as at Weston Schools.

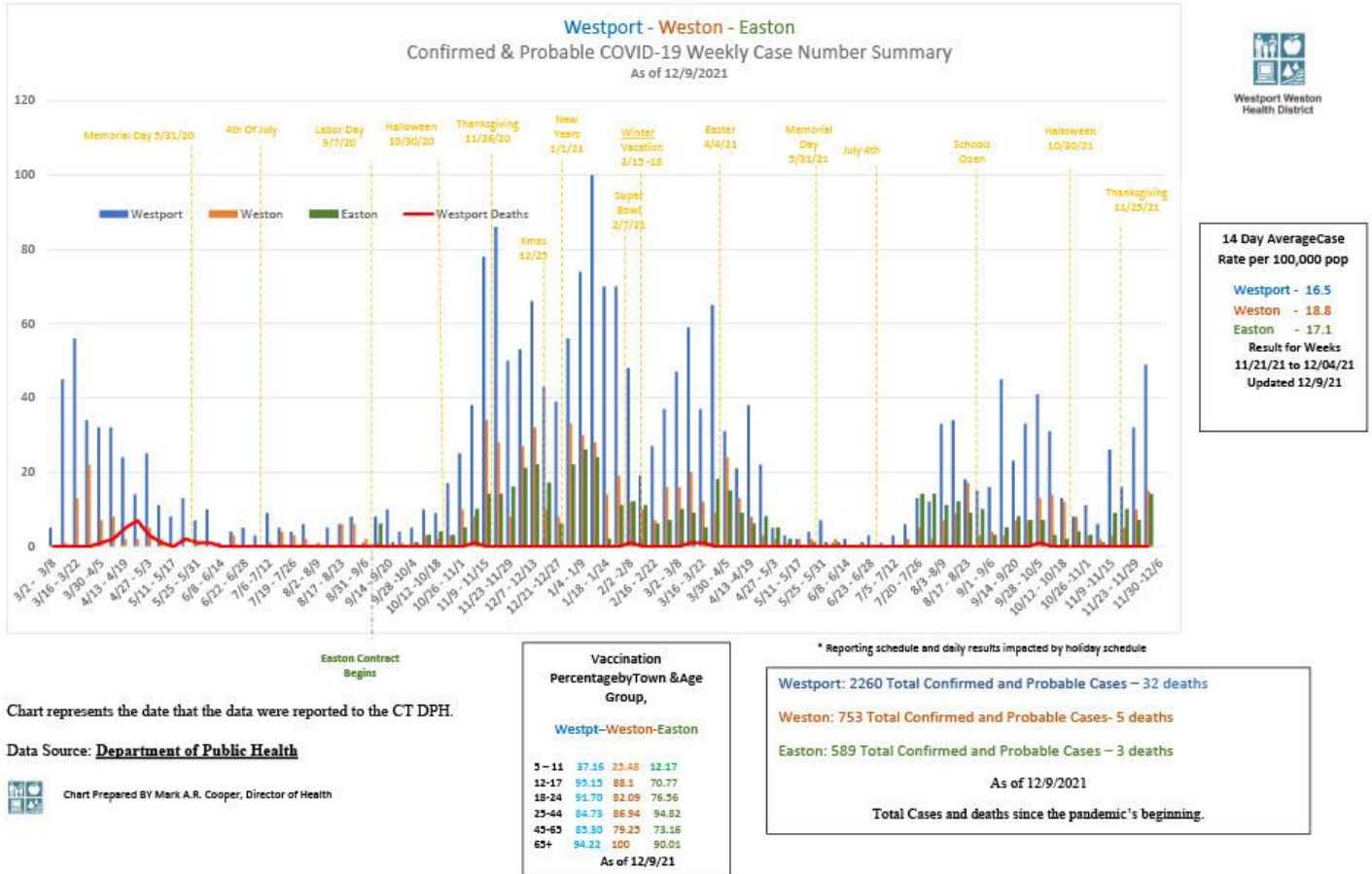


Chart represents the date that the data were reported to the CT DPH.
