Hello Weston. First Selectwoman Sam Nestor here with an important Covid update.

Since December 30, 2021 we have had 77 new cases with the total accumulated Covid numbers for Weston at 1023.

#### Test kits:

We have acquired another allocation of test kits from the State of CT and have begun to distribute them based on State guidelines. We have 300 kits available for public distribution. Each kit contains 2 tests. We hope to be able to provide kits to those who may have not been able to collect one on 1/3/22.

\*\*\* Please note, due to the limited supply of kits to distribute, we are providing kits to those experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 or who were likely exposed to someone who is COVID positive.

When: 1/8/22 from 2:00 to 3:30pm

• Where: Weston Middle School

Quantity: 1 kit per household

#### How:

- All vehicles MUST enter School Road from Weston Road. School Road will be closed at Lord's Highway.
- The access drive to the middle school will be closed until 1:45, vehicles that arrive early will be turned away.
- You must remain in your vehicle while waiting to receive your kit and masks are mandatory while interacting with staff.
- Proof of Residency Required. First come first serve.

Monday's distribution went smoothly in large part to our community working together. We hope that we can continue the same level of cooperation this Saturday.

Thank you to the entire Emergency Management Team for their hard work putting this together, and to all of you for your patience as we work through the distribution logistics.

Please remember the importance of wearing masks, exercising caution in private settings, and staying home if you are feeling sick.

Your health and safety is the utmost priority, please do all that you can to stay safe and healthy.
