

Hello Weston. First Selectwoman Sam Nestor here with an important Covid update.

As of March 4, 2022 we have had 17 new cases over the past week with the total accumulated Covid numbers for Weston at 1294.

As of February 28, 2022 masks are optional in all municipal buildings. Please see here for the notice <https://www.westonct.gov/home/showpublisheddocument/7243/637812935570395611>

Along with this change all Municipal Properties are open to regular business. Appointments are no longer be necessary; however we will still require social distancing in our buildings and will not hold any group meetings until further notice with the exception of the Library - see here https://www.westonpubliclibrary.org/main/wp-content/uploads/20220226_Phase10.pdf

Please note: Masks may still be required in other locations outside the municipal authority. They include healthcare facilities, facilities housing vulnerable populations, public and private transit, and correctional facilities.
