## WESTON PARKS & RECREATION COMMISSION MEETING APPROVED MINUTES MONDAY, NOVEMBER 4, 2019 7:45 P.M.

## WESTON TOWN HALL DAUGHERTY COMMISSION ROOM

Official actions of the commission in these minutes are indicated by <u>underlining</u>.

The Weston Parks and Recreation Commission (WPRC) held its regular monthly meeting on Monday November 4, 2019 at Weston Town Hall. Commissioners present: Eric Albert, Ed Bello, Carl Bernstein, Kirby Brendsel, Elizabeth Pocsik, and Michael Schramm. Also present was: Dave Ungar (Director Parks & Recreation), as well as the following representing Weston Little League – Mark Carioto, Roneil Icatar, Tim Lawler, and Jake Makmale. Chairwoman Pocsik called the meeting to order at 7:46 p.m.

- 1) There was a motion to approve the minutes of the regular monthly Commission meeting on October 7, 2019 by Commissioner Bernstein that was seconded by Commissioner Albert. Motion was approved. For: 6 / Against: 0.
- 2) Public Forum:
  - a) Weston Little League proposing BSP #1 conversion to 50/70 field
    - i) Project would encompass expansion of infield and alteration (elongation) of the pitchers mound (kept as a real mound) to allow for pitching from either distance, as well as some irrigation and electrical modifications.
    - ii) Conversion would be undertaken to make it a Premier Field (one in which different age / aligned ages can play upon), to help keep kids interested in Little League and meet age and other requirements (e.g., field and distance configurations).
    - iii) Configuration alterations would also alow for playing under other possible future field alignments as well (e.g., Cal Ripken).
    - iv) Goal is have conversion completed and ready to play on by Spring 2020.
    - v) Weston Little League would pay for the costs of the conversion.
    - vi) There was a motion by Commissioner Albert to allow for the conversion of BSP #1 to a 50/70 field as proposed that was seconded by Commissioner Schramm. Motion was approved. For: 6 / Against: 0.
- 3) Unfinished Business
  - a) Review of action items due from October 7, 2019 monthly scheduled meeting: None
  - b) Other Unfinished Business: None
- 4) Reports of standing committees and resulting motions:

- a) Administrative Committee (Mr. Crowley and Dave Ungar Director Parks & Recreation):
  - i) Review of Enterprise Fund Report for FY 2019
    - (1) Seen as a positive program year, with strong results returning over ~10% (~\$87K) more than last year to the town based on programs
  - ii) Director Parks & Recreation Dave Ungar provided an update on the potential RecTrac upgrade that it was on hold as the aligned funding from the School is still pending.
- b) Aquatics Committee (Ms. Pocsik):
  - i) Pool temperature is currently fairly constant and holding within range of acceptable levels at 82 82.3 degrees Fahrenheit. Continuing to monitor pool temperature as we transition to Winter / heating season.
- c) Fields Committee (Mr. Bernstein & Mr. Schramm):
  - (1) Director Parks & Recreation Dave Ungar provided an update on the research into Morehouse Farm Park Fields wheelchair access review.
    - (a) Director Parks & Recreation Dave Ungar met with the Weston Town Building Inspector and ADA Compliance Officer to research the question posed. After their meeting, it was determined that we are 100% compliant, but the Weston Town Building Inspector and ADA Compliance Officer is checking further at an upcoming conference to see if there are any other additional potential options.
    - (b) Director Parks & Recreation Dave Ungar provided an update on fields status. Overall, the fields remained in good shape this year as it was not as wet this last year, and other than a few issues (such as a few irrigation mains breaks), it was not as bad a season on the fields.
- d) Programs Committee (Mr. Albert and Dave Ungar Director Parks & Recreation)
  - i) Commission reviewed the Program Supervisor report for Fall / Winter Programs. Overall concensus was positive, and initial winter registration figures are trending well.
- e) Parks Committee (Mr. Bernstein): None

  - a) Commission discussed Weston Little Leagues upcoming proposal for conversion of BSP # 1 to a 50 / 70 field. (Conducted during Public Forum)
